Theism & Meaning

Distinguish between the following two questions:

- 1. Is there a God?
- 2. If there is no God, is everything pointless?

In what ways is God's (possible) existence relevant to the Meaning of Life?

Theism = the claim that there is at least one supernatural being.

If There is No God, Is Everything Pointless?

Ways Theism Might Help Give Life Meaning

1. There is a satisfying explanation for the origin and sustenance of the universe.

- 2. Good will triumph over Evil.
- 3. God loves and cares about us.
- 4. There is an answer to the question "Why be moral?"
- 5. There is Cosmic Justice.
- 6. Everyone is of equal worth.
- 7. There is life after death.

Is There a God?

Grant, for the sake of argument, that if God does not exist, then everything is pointless. Does this give us a reason to think that God does in fact exist?

Epistemic Reasons.

An *epistemic reason* to believe that p is a consideration that provides you with evidence that p is true.

Pragmatic Reasons.

A *pragmatic reason* to believe that p is a consideration that provides you with evidence that believing the p will be in your interest.

Do we have epistemic or pragmatic reasons to believe in God?
